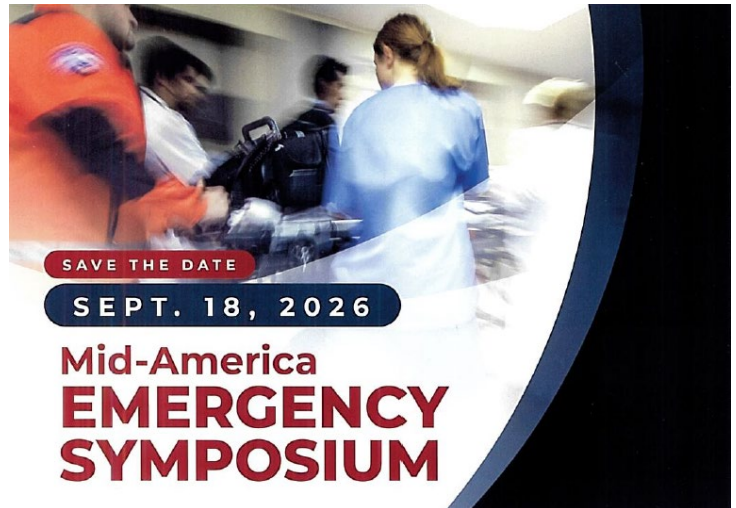


EMS Update

Changes to Protocol Testing

Additional times/dates have been added to the options for testing at JMHS. These are now scheduled times. All protocol testing will be scheduled through HealthStream moving forward.

Due to a large-scale project within Memorial Health, many locations for protocol testing will be moved to alternate sites starting in October. Please be attentive to the scheduled locations. Additionally, many of the sessions will not be in computer labs due to room unavailability. For those dates the HealthStream registration will advise that attendees will need to bring their own laptops.



IDPH Division of EMS is Moving

IDPH is in the process of moving. If you mail correspondence or payment to IDPH, please double check the address on the initial communication. This is a great time to reiterate that paying licensure fees online (which does charge a processing fee) is the easiest and least time-consuming. Online renewals are completed instantly rather than days to weeks later. As a reminder, the IDPH Office is not open to the public. Any interaction at the IDPH Office requires an appointment.
